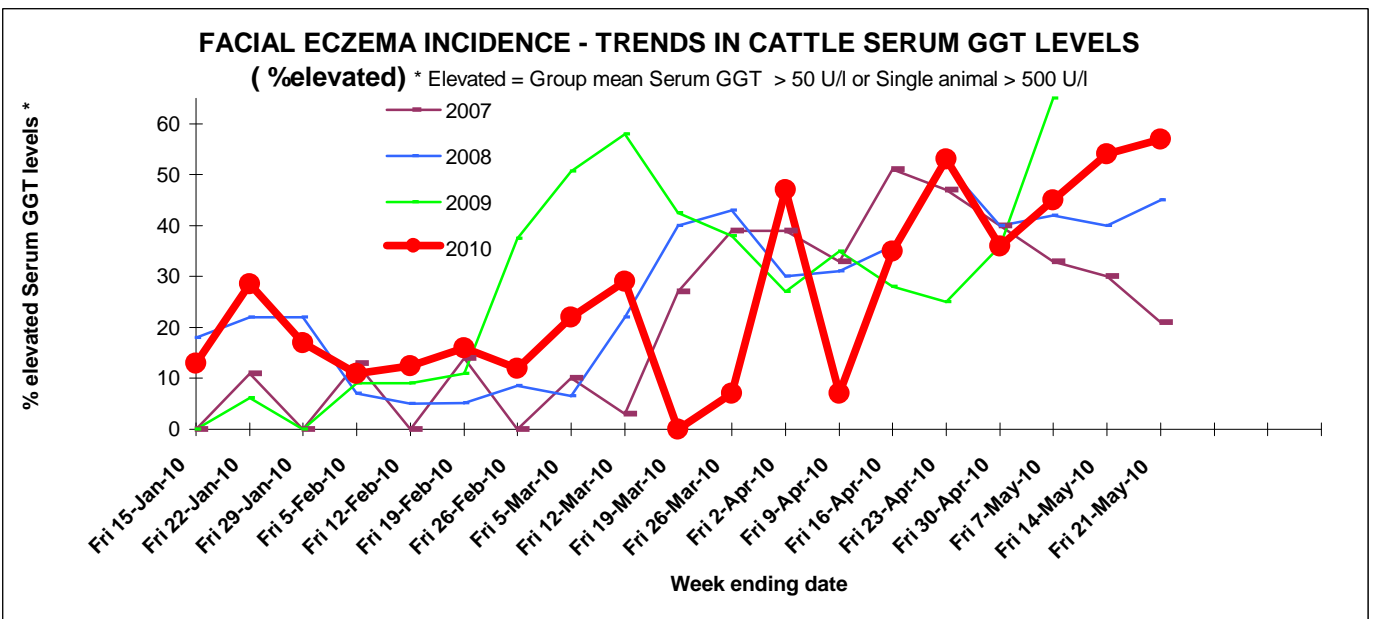
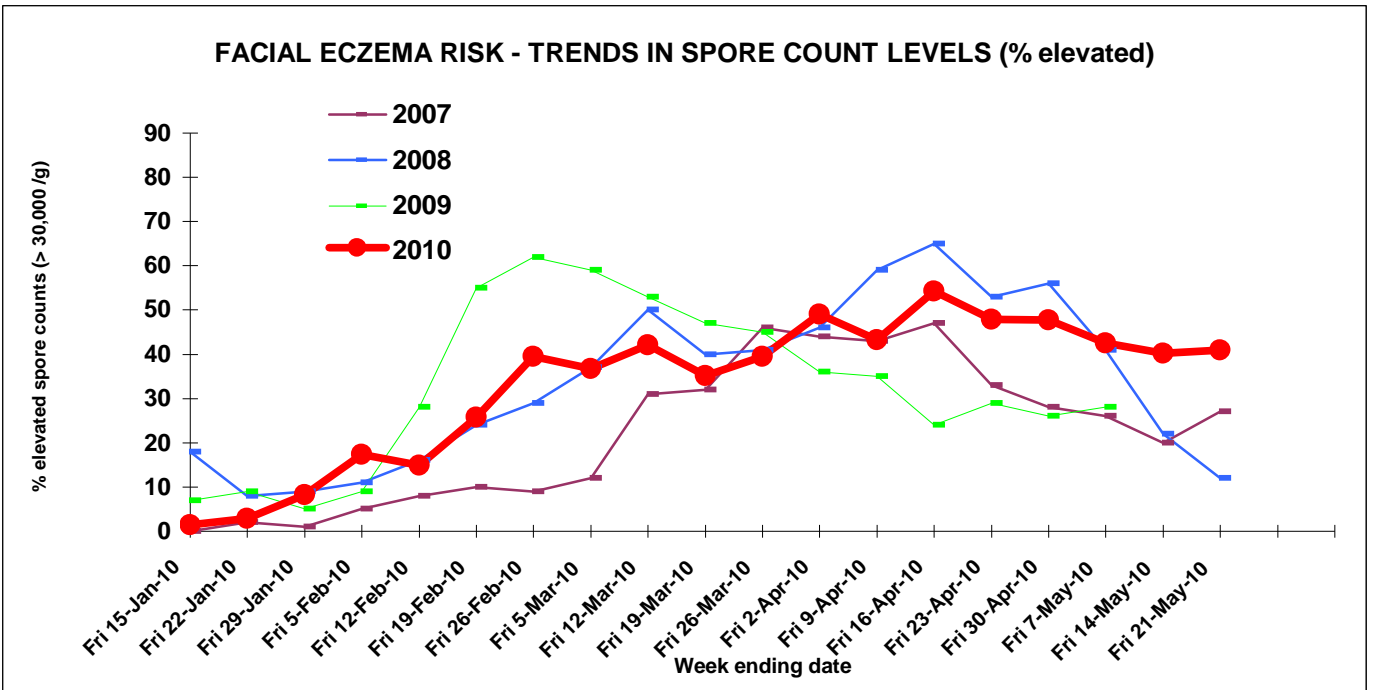


FACIAL ECZEMA RISK AND INCIDENCE MONITOR NO 19

Clinical cases & sub-clinical cases have been reported in the Waikato this week and I'm sure this will not be the only district with affected animals. Spores remain high in some areas due to the continued warmer May conditions, mainly the Waikato and northward. Most counts have dropped throughout the rest of the North Island and it seems the risk would now be low in those areas. 'Hotspots' will need to be monitored until the spores have decreased to safe levels. This will be the last report for the season. Many thanks to all contributors.
